Broughton High School has a wide range of extra-curricular sports and physical activity clubs of offer. We aim to develop the programme in order that as many pupils as possible are engaged in some form of physical activity. In order to subsidise the cost of external coaches, transport to competitions, affiliation fees, equipment and referees/umpires there needs to be a small charge for the activities.

The cost of the Sports Membership is £20 and this allows pupils to participate in as many clubs as they would like over the full year. If you have registered for Free School Meals or receive certain welfare benefits please tick the box as you will be entitled to a free place.

If you do not have access to pay or sign-up online, you can pick up a form from the school office or myself in PE Department.

We aim to begin the all clubs on Monday 27 August but this may vary. Pupils can get exact times from the coach or myself in the PE Department. If clubs have to be cancelled at the last minute, we will try and get this message out through the school bulletin or posters around the school.

All clubs can vary term to term depending on demand and the availability of coaches and facilities. Due to exam leave in term 3, some clubs may cease or run at a reduced level. This is reflected in the overall membership cost.
