Reading and Translation

- Revise all vocabulary from your 5 booklets (1 more after the holidays).
- Past Papers. If you have bought a book you should work on this. Alternatively you can find 2008-10 on the SQA website. We will do the older past papers in class after the holidays. Do the reading and translation papers and mark your work
- Choose a second translation section for each paper. I will mark this for you.
- Do any reading activities in your booklet which we didn't do in class. Roughly 1 in each booklet.
- For any of the reading passages in your booklets, choose any short 5-6 line section and translate. I will mark this for you.
- Surf the Internet in French. Start with <u>www.google.fr</u> and see where it takes you. Remember that your key search word or phrase should be in French.
- Any reading from the websites below e.g. news, TV schedules.

Directed Writing

- Revise all grammar notes, paying particular attention to Perfect and Imperfect Tenses.
- Revise all essays completed this session.
- Practise essays under exam conditions give yourself roughly 40 minutes. You can use the past papers from the last 3 years. I will make these for you.
- Learn complex phrases which would fit any essay.
- If you struggle with this paper, learn a generic essay. Prepare 2-3 middle paragraphs, 1 on an exchange visit, 1 on a working holiday, 1 on a visit to a school.

- Practise writing short essays under exam conditions. Give yourself 30 minutes. I will mark these for you.
- Learn some openers, connectors, endings and essay phrases from your skills booklet. These could be used for any short essay.
