Our top ten actions to keep us safe in our school!

1. Entering and leaving the building



- The bell will ring at 8.25am at which point you can access the building. You will not be allowed in the building before then.
- The Main Entrance and Hub Entrance should be used.
- You should make your way directly to your registration class.
- Leave the building by any exit at the end of the day. Don't hang around in the Hub, foyer or corridors.

2. Handwashing



Washing your hands is one of the easiest ways to protect yourself and others from Covid.

Wash your hands as often as possible and always...

- When you arrive at school
- After break and lunch time

3. Hand Sanitise



- If you can't wash your hands, use the hand sanitiser provided.
- Sanitise your hands when you enter the classroom.
- Sanitise your hands throughout the day.
- There are hand sanitisers around the school for you to use.
- If you are able to, carry your hand sanitiser in your schoolbag.

4. Face Masks

You are encouraged to bring a facemask to school.



You must follow the Scottish Government guidelines when using public transport or within shops, and wear your facemask.

Your teachers and the adults in the school will be wearing facemasks.

Avoid touching your face. If you notice others touching their face, remind them not to!

This will help to fight the spread of infection.

5. Social Distancing



Social distancing should be observed with staff at all times.

6. Cleaning Surfaces

- Clean your desk at the start and end of each lesson.



- Put your bag on the floor underneath your desk.

8. Coughs and Sneezes



- Cough into a tissue
- Put it in the bin and wash/sanitise hands immediately
- If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into the crook of your arm.

9. Your Classroom

- Your classrooms will look different.
 - You will be sitting side by side.
 - You will be seated alphabetically.



10. Breaks and Lunchtime



You will be expected to go outside during break and lunchtime. A wet weather plan will be shared in due course.

S1 must stay on the school grounds during break and lunchtime.

S2, S3 and S4 must stay on the school grounds at break but can go into the community at lunchtime. We expect you to behave responsibly!

What if I am feeling unwell?

If you start to feel unwell during the school day let a member of staff know and they will help you.

If you develop symptoms at home, you should not attend school and home should let the school know that this is the reason for your absence.
