

October Applicants

If you are applying for medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, veterinary science or any courses at Oxford or Cambridge Universities your UCAS application MUST be sent by October 15th. This is because they are very popular and demanding courses and the selection procedure is more rigorous. This can include interviews and sending off examples of written work.

Your academic achievements must be impressive and you should have relevant experience in your chosen area. They will also closely scrutinise your personal statement and the school's academic reference. For more details, check the relevant webpages from the university you are applying to.

If applying for dentistry, medicine, veterinary science or veterinary medicine, you are restricted to a maximum of four choices in any one of these subjects.
