Your son/daughter has chosen to take this course, which is a very practical one. Practical work takes place each week. This course has two units, Cake Baking and Cake Finishing. This course uses many expensive ingredients in the making and decoration of cakes. The cost of food is **£40** for the whole year.

The balance can be paid through ParentPay, you will have received a letter recently with your sign up code and instructions. If you cannot access ParentPay for any reason you can hand in cash or a cheque to the school office. If you are paying by cheque or cash, please use the return slip below. The slip will be returned to you as a receipt for money paid. Please do not hesitate to get in touch with guidance staff or the class teacher if you are unable to pay or would like to pay in instalments.

Students will make food products each week, including assessments for the course award. A large labelled box brought each practical day, will save money and waste in the environment. Students will also be issued with ONE silver cake board for the whole year and they *must* bring this back every lesson.

Due to the high fat and sugar content of the products made, we recommend students observe healthy eating advice. Cakes can also be given as gifts/birthday presents to family and friends.
