SCIENCE

What is it?

- The qualification requires that you carry out a scientific project over the course of the academic year.
- This project can be entirely of your choosing and be based upon your interests.



What is it?

- However the project must cross over between two distinct subject areas – one of which must be a Science.
- You will be encouraged to make contact and work with professionals in your chosen field, for example at the local University.



Who Can Do It?

● **ANYONE** can do the project

- This is called the Interdisciplinary Project (IP)
- Credit for the IP shall appear in your summer certificate (16 SCQF points or half an Adv. Higher)

Who Can Do It?

- To get credit for the full Baccalaureate candidates must complete the project AND
- Complete TWO Adv. Highers and ONE Higher
- One of the courses **MUST** be Maths at either level
- The other two courses could either be
 - Two from the Science list below
 - Or one from the Science list and one from the Technologies list

Eligible Courses List

- Science List

Biology, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Geology, Human Biology, Physics

- Technologies List

Building Construction, Computing, Fabrication and Welding Engineering, Geography, Graphic Communication, Information Systems, Managing Environmental Resources, Mechatronics, Psychology, Product Design, Technological Studies

Criteria For Full Baccalaureate Pass

- To achieve the full Baccalaureate with distinction you must:
 - Get a grade A in an Advanced Higher and a grade A in another component
 - As well as a grade B or above in all other components
- To achieve a full Baccalaureate pass you need a grade C in all components
