All our new S1 intake for 2024 are invited to attend the Three-Day Visit on 18th, 19th, and 20th of June to experience their new school and to participate in some of the classes they will have in August. They will also meet their teachers, key Student Support staff and S5/6 buddies, linked to their new Tutor groups.

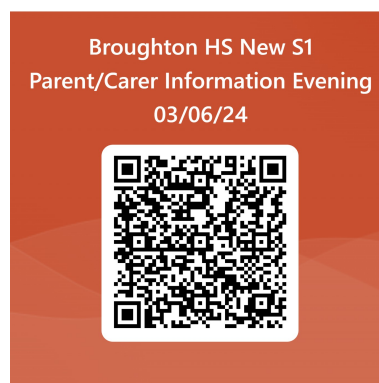
There are 240 families joining our school community, so we would ask that P7 students do not attend and that, wherever possible, only one member of the household attends.

Information on uniform expectations

Uniform – On the three-day visit, students should wear their primary school uniforms.

From August

Broughton High School has a strong community ethos, and we encourage our students to respect this by following our school dress code. Our dress code for all students is as follows.

- White shirt /black shirt/blouse
- Red tie (* see below)
- Black trousers/skirt
- Black Cardigan
- V-neck sweater - black
- Black shoes

We have found that the shirt and tie is the most affordable and flexible option for parents.

The reasons for asking students to wear school dress are as follows:

- Identity; Security; Safety and to minimise the cost of the school day.

PE have a dress code of red top and black bottoms (shorts/tracksuit) bottoms. These can be of any make, as long as they are red and black.

*On the first day of the visit, it is our intention that all new S1 pupils will be given their school tie which has been provided by the Broughton Association. They will also receive their S1 timetable and an S1 Parent Information Pack.
